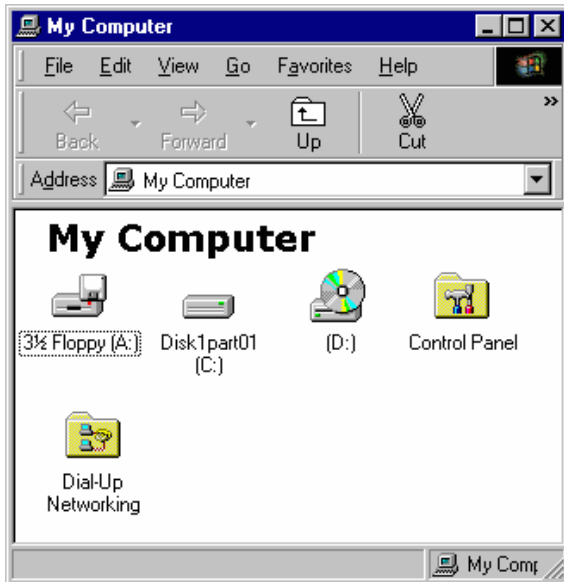
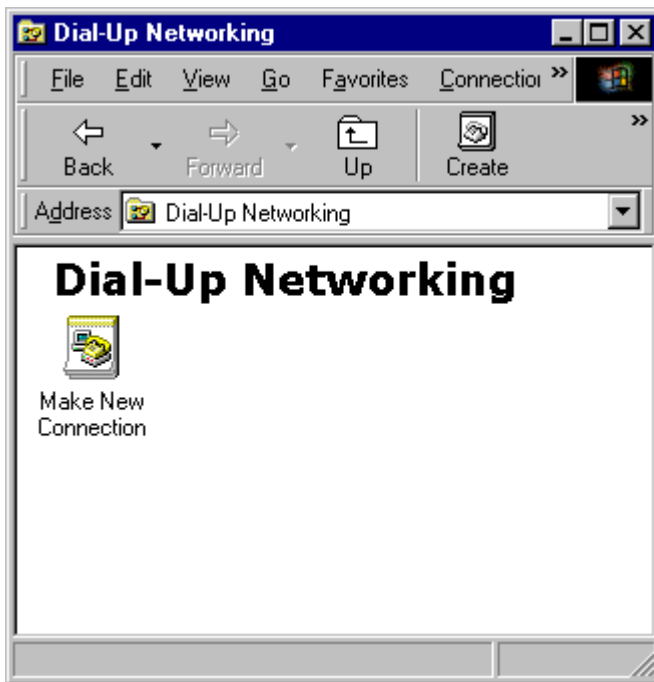


Step 1: Double-click the My Computer icon.

Step 2: Double-click the Dial-Up Networking folder.

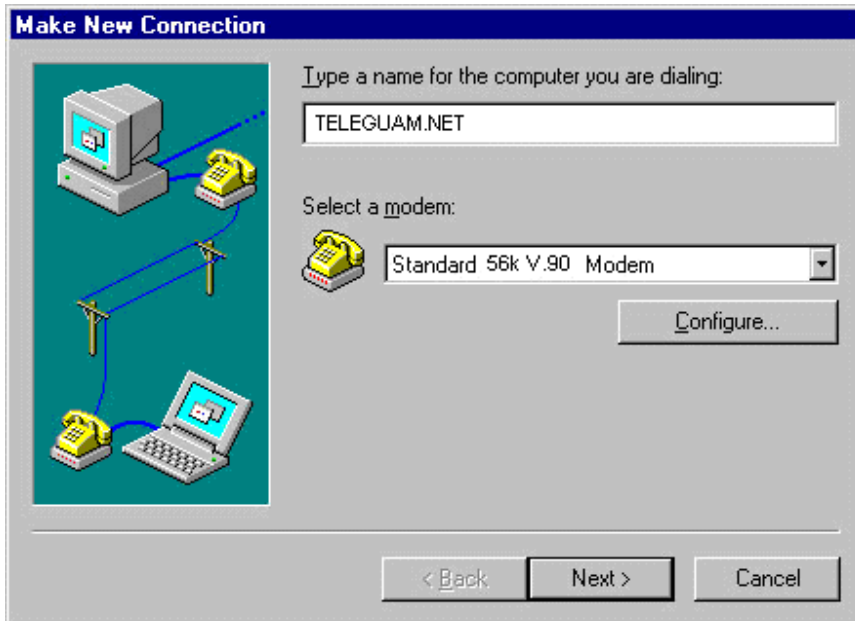


Step 3: Double-click the Make New Connection icon.



Step 4: Under Type a name for the computer you are dialing, type TELEGUAM.NET

Step 5: Click the Next button.



Step 6: In the Area code and Telephone number boxes, type 671 & the GTA Internet dialup access number.

Step 7: Uncheck "Dial using the area code and country code"

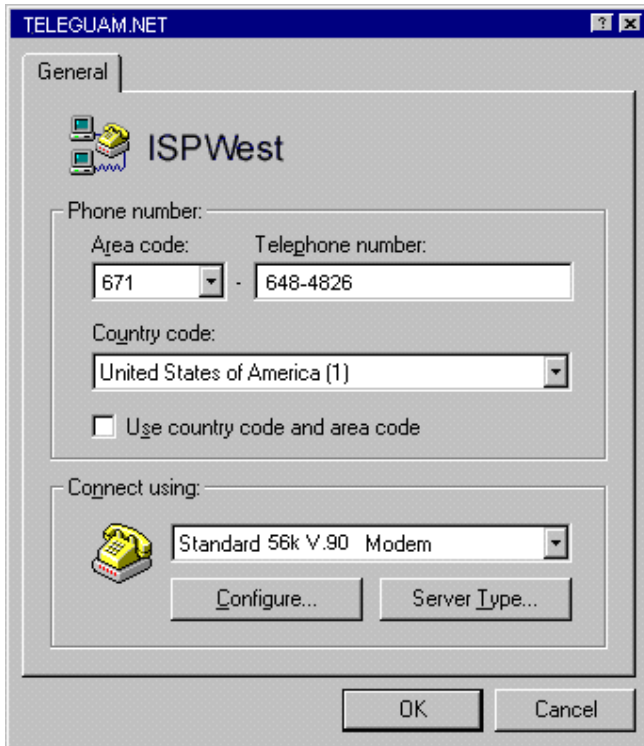
Step 8: Click the Next button.

Step 9: Click the Finish button.

Step 10: To create a shortcut to this connection on your desktop: right click on the TELEGUAM.NET icon and click Create Shortcut. (An error message will pop up saying that windows can't create a shortcut here, would you like to create one on the desktop instead, click yes.)

Step 11: Next, in the Dial-Up Networking window, right click on the TELEGUAM.NET icon and click Properties.

Step 12: Click the Server Type button. (Or click the Server Type tab for Windows 98)



Step 13: For Type of Dial-Up Server, select PPP: Windows 95, Windows NT 3.5, Internet.

Step 14: Uncheck Log on to network.

Step 15: Check Enable software compression.

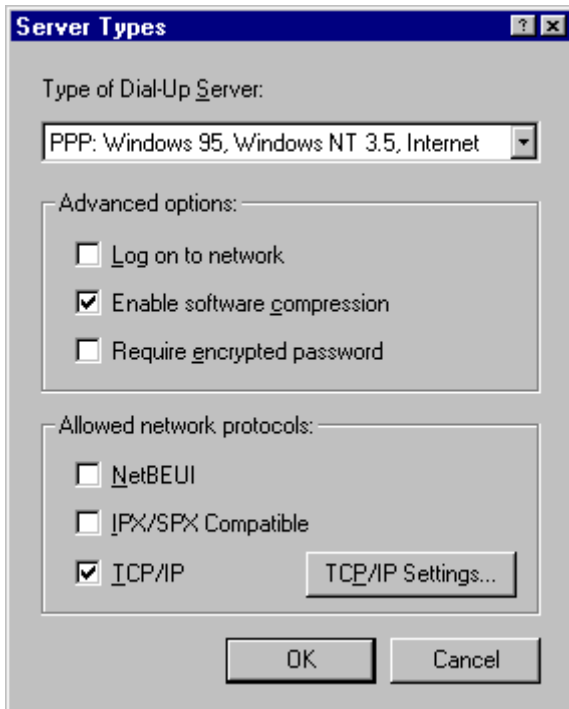
Step 16: Uncheck Require encrypted password.

Step 17: Uncheck NetBEUI.

Step 18: Uncheck IPX/SPX Compatible.

Step 19: Check TCP/IP.

Step 20: Click the OK button.



Step 21: Click the OK button.

Step 22: To Connect, Double Click your newly created TELEGUAM.NET Icon

Step 23: Enter in your primary email address (username)

Step 24: Enter in your Password
