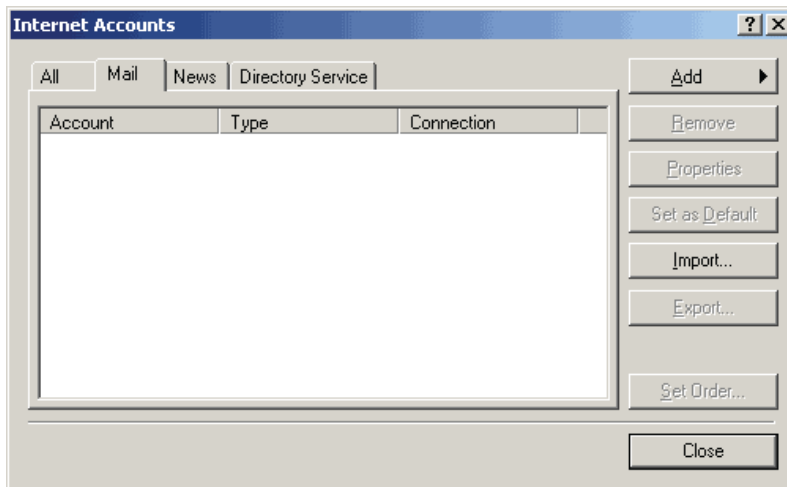
SMTP Outgoing Mail Server: smtp.tele Guam.net
POP Incoming Mail Server: pop.tele Guam.net

Step 1: Load Outlook Express

Step 2: Select Accounts from the Tools menu

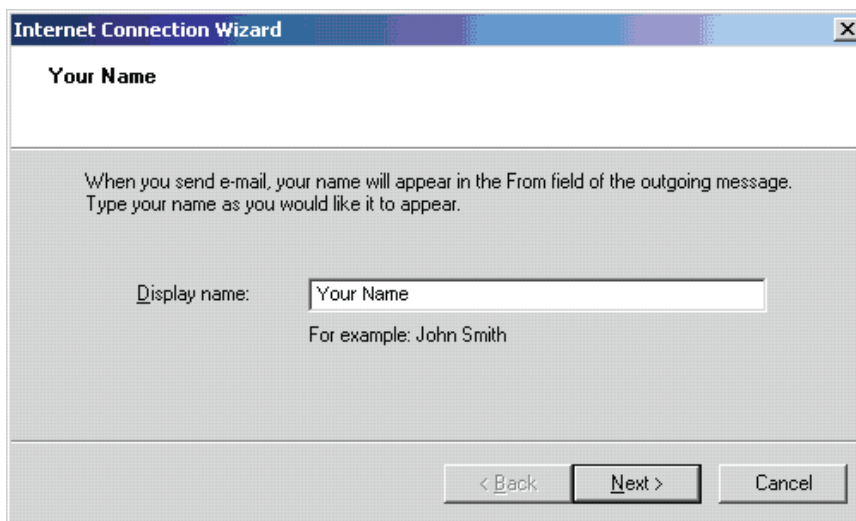
Step 3: Click the Add Button

Step 4: Select Mail from the drop-down menu.




Step 5: Enter your name in the Display Name field.

Step 8: Click the Next button.





Step 11: Fill in the Outgoing mail (SMTP) server field with smtp.teleguam.net


Step 12: Click the Next button

Step 14: Enter your password into the Password field, then click Next.


